

Important Information:

Our formal Orientation Day has been cancelled due to the refurbishment delays to the school. In light of this, other measures will be put in place so that the students are properly acquainted with the school environment, rules and regulations. I ask that you please keep checking the Dean's portal as well for any updates, timetables etc.

1. Students are required to report to the first day of school, **Monday 2nd September**, in their **dress uniforms (long sleeve white shirt and blue pants)**. Note: The school ties would have not yet been collected so a concession will be made on this day.
2. **Monday 2nd September:** Students will arrive at school and will be ushered to their respective classes by the Prefects and Management team. Students are to be prepared with their books for Periods 1-4. The rest of the day will be used to carry out some of the student orientation activities. Students are asked to bring in their locks for their lockers and a spare key.
3. **Tuesday 3rd September:** students are to bring their books for Periods 1-6. The rest of the day's proceedings will also cater for the remainder of our student orientation program.
4. Timetables are posted on the Dean's online portal.
5. **School ties and PE uniforms** would be made available for **collection during the first week of school**. Students who did not yet order ties or PE uniforms can do so during the first week as well. Stay tuned for further details of this.
6. **Outstanding payments of SIF** can be made at the main office.
7. Any documents that have not yet been submitted, kindly send them in during the first week. Remember only photocopies (not originals) are required.
8. Whatsapp groups have not yet been created so please keep updated with information on Dean's online portal.
9. Any medical conditions of the student should be drawn to our attention via email with the supportive medical documents.
10. The student centered portion of our orientation has been integrated within the first 2 days of school. However, the part of the program that deals with the Dean's address to the parents and the Parent Q&A session has not yet been reconfigured. Please rest assured that measures will be made for this significant aspect of our parents also being oriented into the school system.
11. Anyone interested in the School Feeding Program, lunches will be available from the second week of school. We are asking that if you are in need of this school lunch to kindly send a handwritten letter inclusive of the student's name and class requesting to be on the program with a brief description of circumstances. This should be done by Wednesday 4th September.
